Admission Details

During this academic year 2018-2019, 350 students were admitted in the various first year UG courses and 10 students were admitted in the first year PG courses. Out of the 350 students, 24% belong to SC & ST Category, 55% belong to BC category and 13% belong to MBC Category & 4% belong to OC Category. The religion wise split up of the admitted students is as follows Christians 24 %, Hindus 25% and Muslims 19 %.
